Cllr M Bramer explained the council's obligations under the LGA 1972 \$123 \$.2(9) and \$127 (2) in relation to advertising the disposal of land and obtaining best value. It was agreed that the council had no choice but to agree to this as it had been pointed out to the council by our solicitor (KCC Legal Scheme). Cllr Bramer proposed to recommend to Full Council that in order to comply with its obligations under the Local Government Act (1972) the clerk should be instructed to advertise in the local press for two consecutive weeks the Council's intention:-

- (1) to renew its Lease with Meopham Cricket Club
- (2) to grant an easement to Mr. David Grey for the installation of utilities to his property under Meopham Green

The clerk is also instructed to take any necessary action advised by the Council's solicitor as being required to comply with its obligations under Section 127(2) of the Act.

It is further resolved that all expenditure resulting from the above resolution shall be charged to the Administration and Resources Standing Committee 'General Administration' budget.
