Item 1 Apologies for Absence

Item 3 Approve the Minutes of the previous meeting (05.04.19)

J3 The minutes of the meeting held on 05.04.19 were approved as a correct record on a proposal by Cllr Wade and seconded by Cllr Buchanan. All voted in favour.
