Annual GBC Parking Report 2017/18 Nick May GBC

A detailed explanation of the Annual Parking Report which had been previously circulated, was given by Nick May, the Deputy Team Leader at GBC. He then answered questions about the Report from the group members. Enforcement Officers were on patrol daily throughout the Borough , Mon-Fri 6.00am to 8.30pm, 6.00am to 4.00pm Sat and 6,00am to 2.00pm Sunday

Discussion re future direction of campaign and Camer Parade Issues.

- It was decided to continue the campaign and continue to monitor progress before reviewing the direction it should take in future.
- Encourage more Parking Enforcement Officer visits
- The number of banners was to be reduced to the entrances to the Village and close to schools and possibly on the BiG M railing. Paul to advise on the most suitable siting in the Culverstone Vigo stretch of the A227
- The question raised by Jackie Fuller at the previous meeting about the possibility of low barriers close to the kerb at the exit north end of Camer Parade, to deter or prevent illegal parking on the double yellow lines, on Wrotham Road, was deferred until the next meeting.
- Some leaflets were still available and would be redistributed to 'friendly' stores and other outlets.
- The long saga of the Trixie Mirror remains unresolved, though our KCC representative had undertaken to raise the issue with KCC once more.
- The School Close Shoppers Car Park has been examined again by Nick May, and consideration to be given to recommend improvements for all users.
- 70 pedometers were still available for distribution.
